- 4. How does Lieutenant Joe Leaphorn approach the investigation? What methods does he use?
- 5. How do the Navajo and Zuni cultures differ in their beliefs and practices, according to the novel?

Analytical & Thematic Questions

- 6. What is the significance of the title *Dance Hall of the Dead*?
 - (How does it relate to the Zuni concept of life after death and George's quest?)
- 7. How does Hillerman use the mystery genre to explore Native American cultural identity?
- 8. In what ways does the novel address themes of alienation or belonging?
- 9. How does Leaphorn's identity as a Navajo affect his perspective on the Zuni people and the investigation?
