<u>Fish in a Tree</u> Project:

Choose one of the characters in the book and make a Character Head. The template is attached along with examples. All work on the Character Head must be your own work – your own handwriting and drawing. Please follow these directions for completing your Character Head:

- *Character Head should be on cardstock or securely glued on a piece of construction paper (no large posters, please)
- *Character's name should be written in the largest script
- *Include the title of the novel and author
- *Include one significant character quote. Use quotation marks and be exact. Include the page number where the quote can be found in the book.
- *Include two images that represent your character
- *Briefly describe a turning point event involving the character
- *Use an attractive color scheme with virtually no white space
- *All script needs to be legible, dark, and attractive (please do not use pencils)
- *Handwriting needs to be neat, free from grammatical and spelling errors
- *Your name, date, and class period should be on the back of the project

Project grade will be based on following the above directions.
