




What is IXL?

IXL is a subscription based on-line learning site of skills in math, science, language arts, social studies, and Spanish for students in grades K5-12.

It is designed to give students practice on essential skills at their own pace with immediate feedback and instructional support.

Where do we go to get started?

Your child will have a user name and a password supplied by his/her teacher. Simply log in.





How much time should my child be spending on IXL at home?

- Each teacher's assignments will vary.
- On average, your child should be spending no more than 30 minutes a day on IXL.
- Your child will have individual skills assigned to him/her and possibly a goal date for completion.
- Always reach out to the teacher when you have a concern.

What's a Smart Score?

"IXL's SmartScore is a dynamic measure of progress toward mastery, rather than a percentage grade. It tracks your skill level as you tackle progressively more difficult questions. Consistently answer questions correctly to reach excellence (90), or conquer the Challenge Zone to achieve mastery

So ... if the Smart Score isn't really like a grade ... what exactly does it mean?

0 - 70 = I'm Practicing the Skill

71 - 89 = I'm Refining and Perfecting This Skill

At 80 = I Have Mastered the Skill

90 -100 = I Am Challenging Myself at a Higher Level of Mastery
