



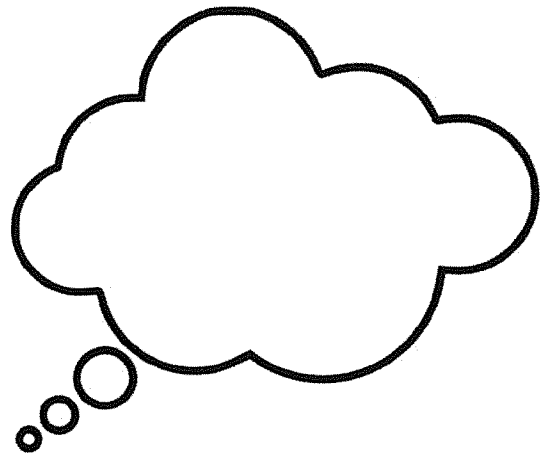
# It's Quotable

## SHOUTING AT THE RAIN

You are going to choose one of two activities that focuses on quotes from the book. Shouting at the Rain by Lynda M. Hunt is filled with memorable lines and great 'life lessons.' As you read, jot down the lines or passages that really impress you. If you own the book, you can hi-light and place sticky notes on the pages. Your goal is to have fifteen quotes by the end ... trust me ... it will be easy with this book. If you have more than fifteen, you'll have to narrow it down. After you've finished reading, in your very best handwriting on loose leaf notebook paper in pen, write those fifteen quotes, record the page number and who said it, and tell a little bit of the back story for the quote. You will turn these quotes in with your project on August 12, 2021. Both projects will require a presentation in class. Your quotes assignment will be your first quiz grade. Your project, its presentation, and a reading quiz will be your first test grade.

### Project Idea #1

Create a poster (22"X28") using all original artwork and lettering. Choose five(5) of your fifteen(15) quotes. Put those quotes on your poster with an illustration for each. Your poster should have the book title and author, make good use of the space, and be visually appealing and neatly done. Be sure your lettering is legible and level. Remember, all work must be hand-done for this project. Artists - this one's for you!



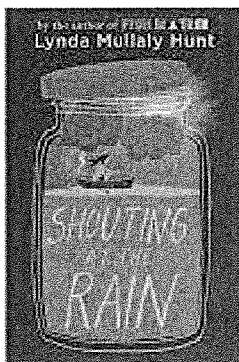
