## Lee Academy Graduation Requirements

A minimum of 24 credits is required for graduation. Students who do not meet this requirement will not be allowed to participate in graduation exercises. Credits must be earned as follows:

4 English credits
4 math credits
4 Science credits
3 Social Studies credits
2 Foreign Language credits
1 Fine Arts credit
1 Computer credit
1 Physical Education credit
4 Electives
Students begin earning high school credits (Carnegie units) in the $8^{\text {th }}$ grade when they take English I and Algebra I. The additional $8^{\text {th }}$ grade courses of $8^{\text {th }}$ Science, $8^{\text {th }}$ History, $8^{\text {th }}$ Writing, and $8^{\text {th }}$ Health do not earn high school credit. $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students are required to earn a minimum of 80 to progress to English II and/or Algebra II. $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students earning a 79 or below will retake English and/Algebra in the $9^{\text {th }}$ grade. All grades earned in the $9^{\text {th }}-12^{\text {th }}$ grade will show on the transcript.

All high school students will take 6 courses each year with the exception of seniors who may take 5 courses if they do not need more than 5 to graduate.

Lee Academy calculates all GPAs on the South Carolina 5 point Uniform Grading Scale.
Lee Academy partners with Central Carolina Technical College to offer dual-enrollment courses to qualified students. Qualification is by placement test score. Students may sign up to take the Next Generation Accuplacer test during their sophomore, junior or senior year. 6 courses are offered on-campus with the option of additional online courses.
