Lee Academy Graduation Requirements

A minimum of 24 credits is required for graduation. Students who do not meet this requirement will not be allowed to participate in graduation exercises. Credits must be earned as follows:

- 4 English credits
- 4 math credits
- 4 Science credits
- 3 Social Studies credits
- 2 Foreign Language credits
- 1 Fine Arts credit
- 1 Computer credit
- 1 Physical Education credit
- 4 Electives

Students begin earning high school credits (Carnegie units) in the 8^{th} grade when they take English I and Algebra I. The additional 8^{th} grade courses of 8^{th} Science, 8^{th} History, 8^{th} Writing, and 8^{th} Health do not earn high school credit. 8^{th} grade students are required to earn a minimum of 80 to progress to English II and/or Algebra II. 8^{th} grade students earning a 79 or below will retake English and/Algebra in the 9^{th} grade. All grades earned in the 9^{th} – 12^{th} grade will show on the transcript.

All high school students will take 6 courses each year with the exception of seniors who may take 5 courses if they do not need more than 5 to graduate.

Lee Academy calculates all GPAs on the South Carolina 5 point Uniform Grading Scale.

Lee Academy partners with Central Carolina Technical College to offer dual-enrollment courses to qualified students. Qualification is by placement test score. Students may sign up to take the Next Generation Accuplacer test during their sophomore, junior or senior year. 6 courses are offered on-campus with the option of additional online courses.
